

LOWELL HIGH SCHOOL 2013 HONORS NIGHT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION



The annual Lowell High School Honors Night will be held this year on **May 14, 2013** at 6:30 p.m. in the Cyrus W. Irish Auditorium. This packet contains a listing of the **potential** honors and scholarships that will be awarded that night. The enclosed application form will be used by the scholarship committee to select the recipients of the Honors Night Scholarships that are listed in Sections I and II.

These awards are open to any Lowell High School senior who:

- (1) **has a minimum 2.5 GPA**
- (2) **will be furthering his/her education in the Fall of 2013, and**
- (3) **meets any additional qualifying criteria that are listed in the description of each scholarship**

Some scholarships listed in **Section I** of the Lowell High School Honors Night Scholarship List may have **separate applications and may have different deadlines**. Applications for scholarships that require their own application may be obtained from the College and Career Center in room 116.

If noted, Section I applications should be mailed directly to the scholarship sponsor at the address indicated on the application.

For all scholarships listed in Sections I and II use this application unless otherwise noted and attach:

1. **SCHOLARSHIP TRANSCRIPT** - This transcript will identify you by your student ID only. See your Guidance Clerk Scheduler
2. **RESUME** (write your student ID on the top of the resume, no identifying names should appear on the resume)
3. **ESSAY** (write you student ID on the top of the essay, no identifying names should appear anywhere on the essay)
4. **ANY ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION SPECIFIED BY INDIVIDUAL SCHOLARSHIPS**

Directions:

Read Section I and II of the scholarship packet thoroughly.

- 1) Highlight the scholarship(s) you are eligible for in Section I.
- 2) Once you have identified the scholarships you are eligible for you may begin filling out your application.
- 3) Complete the Honors Night Scholarship Application in **black ink**.
- 4) On the application leave the top line titled "Name of Scholarship" - **BLANK**.
- 5) **Your name should not appear anywhere in the application.**
- 6) Add your student ID on your essay and resume and any supporting documents.
- 7) **For copying purposes, count the number of scholarships you highlighted in Section I and add one extra copy for scholarships listed in Section II. (For example, if you highlighted seven scholarships in Section I; you should make eight copies of the completed application packet.)**
- 8) Make double sided copies of your application **leaving the top line blank**. Include all supporting materials when making copies.
- 9) Staple each completed application packet in the upper left-hand corner. Check your packet to ensure that you provide **ALL** the information requested; failure to do so will disqualify you from consideration.
- 10) Write the name of the individual scholarship you are applying for on the top line of **each** application.
- 11) For scholarships listed in Section II, Write "Section II" on the top line titled "Name of Scholarship".
- 12) Included with your application you must attach your scholarship transcript, resume, essay and any supporting documentation required.
- 13) Alphabetize the applications by the donor's last name (following the scholarship packet as a reference). This will save you time when you deliver and file the applications in the College & Career Center.
- 14) **Your name should not appear anywhere** in the LHS application packet. If your name appears anywhere in the packet, your application will be disqualified. This includes your application, transcript, resume, essay, and any supporting documentation.

Incomplete and/or late applications will be disqualified automatically.

(No identifying names should be listed anywhere in your essay.)

This personal essay will help the committee become acquainted with you as an individual and student, apart from courses, grades, and other objective data. It will also demonstrate your ability to organize your thoughts and express yourself.

I certify that the information I have provided is accurate and complete. I understand that it is my responsibility to submit a completed application by the stated deadlines. Failure to do so will result in my application being withdrawn without review.
